28 May 44, Beled out over REBECO. I left NORTH KILLINGHOLLE in a Lancaster aircraft on 27 May 44 at 2200 hrs. I baled out at 0315 hrs over RESECQ (N.W. EUROPE, 1:250,000, Sheet 2, J 43). I landed in an open field and remained there for some time as there was a search going on in the area. About 0900 hrs I was discovered by a farmer who made me understand that he was going to bring help. He returned about 1200 hrs and took me back to his home, where I was given clothes and food. Later on that day I was moved to a large farm nearby, where my photograph was taken for an identity card. I was then moved to a house near ENGHIEN (J 54) where I stayed until 30 May.

3 Sep 44, Centact with American forces. From here I was taken to LOMBISE (J 32) dressed as a policeman, where I remained until 3 Sep, when I made rout at with American forces.
