# Possible visit to RAF Cranwell in 2015

During the course of the weekend we would like to establish potential interest in a visit to RAF Cranwell next year. Opened in 1915 as a Royal Naval Air Service base, Cranwell became the home of the RAF's officer training programme between the wars and played an important part in establishing it as an independent service. College Hall, was completed in 1933 and is a Grade II\* listed building.
